## **Smartphone Free School**

We aim to be a fully 'Smartphone Free school' in September. Smartphones and smart watches will not be allowed on school premises. We please ask that if you feel your child needs a phone at primary age, then you look to purchase a 'brick phone' as a basic communication device. The smartphone free childhood website has been updated significantly and has provided some really clear guides and recommendations for parents around devices, and trackers. Brick phones will be handed in to the class teacher. If a smartphone is seen or heard in school these will be confiscated and kept secure in the school office until a parent collects it.

## **KS2** Ambassadors (after school)

**Y5/6 Consent to walk home** - Children in Y5/6 are able to walk to and from school independently. We require parental <u>consent</u> for this. We ask this is completed for all Y5/6 children each year, even if you gave consent last year. Children without consent will not be permitted to walk home on their own.
